INTEGRATED SECURITY SYSTEM FOR 202 STATIONS

1637. SHRI P. KUMAR:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the status of implementation of Integrated Security System (ISS), which was proposed for 202 important railway stations across the entire railway network;**
- (b) whether the Government proposes to bring in more railway stations under the Integrated Security System (ISS); and**
- (c) if so, the details of the number of railway stations identified for the purpose, State-wise?**

ANSWER

(SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

(a): Out of 202 Railway stations nominated for implementation of Integrated Security System (ISS) over Indian Railways, contracts for execution of ISS work over 117 Railway stations have already been awarded. So far, Close Circuit Television (CCTV) Cameras have been installed over 89 stations under ISS. In addition, 27 Under Vehicle Scanning System (UVSS), 114 baggage scanners, about 240 Door Frame Metal Detectors (DFMD), more than 900 Hand Held Metal Detectors have also been installed by zonal Railways under Integrated Security System.
