**TRAFFIC AT RAILWAY CROSSINGS**

**†1640. SHRI HARIOM SINGH RATHORE:**

**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) the number of such railway crossings, where there is a heavy traffic in various States/Union Territories of the country;**
- (b) the steps, on the part of railways, that have been taken to ensure smooth running of traffic there; and**
- (c) the details of the action plan to build Railway Under Bridge (RUB) at the Phulera end railway crossing where there is a heavy traffic?**

**ANSWER**

**(a) & (b): There are 2,695 level crossings (LCs) having traffic density more than 1 lac Train Vehicle Unit (TVU) in the country as on 01.04.2016. Out of 2,695 LCs, work for elimination of 1,259 LCs by construction of Road Over Bridge (ROBs)/Road Under Bridges (RUBs) has already been sanctioned by Railways.**

**Out of 2,695 LCs, work for elimination of 218 LCs by construction of ROBs/RUBs is to be done by Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH)/National Highway Authority of India (NHAI) at their cost as per Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed**

**between Ministry of Railways and Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH) on 10.11.2014.**

**(c): Work for construction of subway in lieu of level crossing No. 152 in Phulera Yard has been sanctioned.**

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
