DDA HOUSING SCHEMES

No. 1645 SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR:

Will the Minister OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Delhi Development Authority (DDA) proposes to launch a new housing scheme;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the time by which it is likely to be launched:
- (c) the number of flats likely to be constructed under the scheme, location and category-wise; and
- (d) the steps taken/proposed to be taken to make the scheme attractive for customers?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI M. VENKAIAH NAIDU)

(a) to (d): Yes, Madam. The Delhi Development Authority (DDA) has informed that the new housing scheme will include all the available vacant flats of different categories viz. Higher Income Group (HIG), Middle Income Group (MIG), Lower Income Group (LIG), Janta, and Expandable Housing Scheme (EHS) in various localities and no new construction of flats, is envisaged.
