(a): The Sustainable Urban Transport Project (SUTP) is jointly funded by Government of India, State Governments, Project Implementing Agencies (PIUs), International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) (Loan through the World Bank) and Global Environment Facility (GEF) grant through the World Bank and United Nations Development Programme (UNDP). The agency-wise share is as under:
