Part Time Instructors in Maharashtra

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received any proposal from Maharashtra Government regarding approval for the posts of part time instructors under Right to Education (RTE) Act, 2009 during the financial year 2014-15;
- (b) if so, the details thereof as on date; and
- (c) the time by which the said proposal is likely to be finalized along with the reasons for delay therein?

(a) to (c): Yes, Madam. The Department of School Education & Literacy approved the proposal received from the Government of Maharashtra for 5505 part time instructors for 1835 Government upper primary schools in 2014-15.

During the Project Approval Board meeting to discuss the Annual Work Plan & Budget for Maharashtra for 2015-16, it was informed by the State that a faculty of Part Time Instructors would be created and would be used by a number of schools. The State agreed to resubmit a proposal within 2 months for engagement of part time instructors at school level as per local needs of schools from time to time. However, the proposal has not been received from the State Govt.
