EXTENSION OF MACHILIPATNAM EXPRESS

1745. SHRI Y.S. AVINASH REDDY:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Railways has received any representation with regard to extension of Machilipatnam Express up to Kadapa railway station and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the decision taken by the Railways thereon; and
- (c) the funds earmarked and released by the Railways therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

- (a) A large number of representations are received at various level of Railway administration which *inter-alia* include Railway stations, Divisions, Zonal headquarters and at Railway Board's level for extension of trains. However, Indian Railways do not maintain compendium of such representations.
- (b) Extension of trains is an on-going process on Indian Railways subject to operational feasibility, traffic justification, commercial viability etc. However, at present it is not feasible to extend T. No. 17402/17401 Machilipatnam—Tirupati Express up to Cuddapah due to non-availability of rake maintenance facilities at Cuddapah.
- (c) If found feasible, extension of a train is done either by utilizing the same rake if sufficient lie-over time is available or by inducting an additional rake if lie-over time is less and additional rake is available.
