 - i. Transition to modern ICT architecture and adopt and follow all ICT (Information Communication Technology) standards as prescribed by DEITY (Department of Electronics and Information Technology).
 - ii. Leverage and integrate new digital technologies to focus on transforming:
 - 1. Better passenger services.
 - 2. Enhancing freight revenues.
 - 3. Improving railway operations.
 - 4. Optimising internal operations.
- iii. To integrate IT(Information Technology) intervention through mission mode programmes like Integrated Traffic Management, unified HRMS(Human Resource Management System), Energy & Land Management, etc.
- iv). Encourage app developer to create apps involving rail services.
- v). Build in location based services for passenger, freight and safety using Geospatial platform.
