(a) to (b): According to National Association of Software and Services Companies (NASSCOM), the global outsourcing continued its growth with about 8.5 per cent growth in 2015, which is estimated at USD 162-166 billion. India continues to be the World leader in outsourcing destination with a share of 56 percent of the total global outsourcing market size.
