- (a) whether the Government has launched its first Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) train on the Rewari-Rohtak section of Northern Zone during the last year, and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government plans to introduce more CNG trains in the States including Delhi and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government is investing on Research and Development for fuel efficient trains and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether the Government has plans to shift all the existing trains into CNG and Liquified Natural Gas (LNG) trains in a phased manner and if so, the details thereof?

- (a) Yes, Madam one Diesel Electrical Multiple Unit (DEMU) train comprising of 2 CNG DPCs (Driving Power Car) and
 6 TC (Trailing Coach) has been in operations since January, 2015.
- (b) Yes, Madam. Six CNG DEMU trains have been introduced which run in Delhi, Haryana and U.P.
- (c) Indian Railways has sanctioned projects under following major developments for research and development for fuel efficient trains including use of alternate fuels:-
 - Development of advanced fuel injection system.
 - Development of advanced air intake system.
 - Development of natural gas based systems.
 - Promote use of biodiesel as blended fuel.
