SHORTAGE OF POWER IN RAILWAYS

1795. DR. K. GOPAL:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Railways has entered into an agreement with the private producers for supply of electricity;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Railways is facing acute shortage of power; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the corrective steps taken in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

- (a) & (b) Railways have started procurement of power under Open Access. In this process, about 700 Mega Watt (MW) power has till now been tied up from private producers, like M/s. Adani Power and Jindal India Thermal Power Limited (JITPL). In addition, about 500 MW power has also been tied up from Ratnagiri Gas and Power Private Limited (RGPPL).
