(a) Yes Madam, The Government through the Ministry of Science and Technology has taken several steps for improvement and enhancement of capabilities of Universities and Academic Institutions in the Country in research and development. These are i) Fund for Improvement of S & T Infrastructures in Universities and Higher Educational Institutions (FIST), ii) Promotion of University Research and Scientific Excellence (PURSE), iii) Sophisticated Analytical Instrumentation Facility (SAIF) and iv) Boost to University Interdisciplinary Life Science Departments for Education and Research (BUILDER) schemes presently implemented by the Department of Science and Technology (DST) and Department of Biotechnology (DBT) for augmentation of research facilities at different Universities, academic Institutions including Colleges as well as providing services of analytical facilities across the country including the State of Gujarat.

So far 2315 Departments including 301 PG Colleges spread across 450 Universities/ academic Institutions under FIST Scheme, 44 Universities under PURSE scheme, 18 SAIF Centres and 24 Universities under BUILDER scheme have been covered for this purpose.

(b) While no state-wise allocation are made under these schemes, the amount released in last 3 years and the current year with respect to various states on these schemes are given at Annexure-I.
