(a) The details of regional centres set up by the CSIR- National Institute of Oceanography (CSIR-NIO), Goa in the country, State wise are as follows:

1. Andhra Pradesh

Regional Centre of CSIR-NIO, 176, Lawsons Bay Colony, Visakhapatnam - 530017

2. Kerala

Regional Centre of CSIR-NIO, High Court Junction, Abraham Madamakkal Road, Ernakulam - 682018

3. Maharashtra

Regional Centre of CSIR-NIO, Lokhandwala Road, 4 Bungalows, Andheri West, Mumbai - 400053.

(b)&(c) Yes, Madam. Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Govt. of India and France's Universite Pierre Et Marie Curie (UPMC) and Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique (CNRS) have signed an Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on 10th April 2015 to collaborate to set up a frontier institute of marine biology in a period of five years (2016-2021). The Marine Biology Institute is expected to be established in the form of multidisciplinary marine biology and biotechnology research institute. The institute will have its centres in coastal states in Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat and Andaman & Nicobar Islands. The institute will start functioning in Goa at one of the premier Institute like CSIR- NIO/at rented building from 2017. DBT has no further plan to set up any more institutes of Ocean science.
