One National Vocational Training Institute is located in Noida and ten Regional Vocational Training Institutes are located at Mumbai (Maharashtra), Bengaluru (Karnataka), Thiruvananthapuram (Kerala), Panipat (Haryana), Kolkata (West Bengal), Tura (Meghalaya), Allahabad (Uttar Pradesh), Indore (Madhya Pradesh), Vadodara (Gujarat) and Jaipur (Rajasthan).
