#### SECURITY LAPSES AT AIRPORTS

- (a) the details of the incidents of lapses in security taken place at various Airports of the country and whether the same were brought to the notice of Bureau of Civil Aviation Security during the last three years and the current year, year-wise;
- (b) the action taken against the person found guilty in such incidents; and
- (c) the remedial measures taken by the Government to prevent the re-occurrence of such lapses in security at the airports in the country?

### ANSWER

- (a): The details, zone-wise, of the number of cases of security lapses brought to the notice of Bureau of Civil Aviation Security (BCAS), the regulatory authority for civil aviation security in the country, at various airports in the country during the last three years and the current year are annexed.
- (b): BCAS investigated into such lapses on need basis. BCAS brought such security lapses to the notice of the concerned agencies for taking appropriate corrective/remedial action.
- (c): BCAS has issued necessary guidelines/instructions from time to time to avoid such lapses. Some of the steps taken to strengthen security arrangements include time bound deployment of Central Industrial Security Force (CISF) at airports, deployment of Quick Reaction Teams (QRTs) at major airports and regular monitoring of security arrangements through inspections and dummy checks.
