(a)to(c): Govt. of India has decided to set up two new Major Ports at Enayam in the State of Tamil Nadu and at Vadhavan in the State of Maharashtra. In sofar, Rs. 3,95,55,600/- has been released to V.O.Chidambaranar Port Trust, Tuticorin, which is the nodal port for Enayam Port, for preparing the Techno-Economic Feasibility Report for the proposed Enayam Port.
