- (a) the names of the airports of the country, maintenance of which has been given to the private companies completely and the terms and conditions thereof along with the time period for which these have been given;
- (b) whether the maintenance of any other airport of the country is likely to be handed over to the private companies;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the names of the airports which have been given to the GMR group along with the details of the terms and conditions of the contracts thereof;
- (e) whether land has been given on lease to GMR; and
- (f) if so, the rate, time period and the locations thereof?

(a): Airports Authority of India has awarded operation, management and development of Delhi and Mumbai airports to joint venture companies namely, Delhi International Airport Private Limited (DIAL) and Mumbai International Airport Private Limited (MIAL) respectively on long term lease basis for an initial period of thirty years, which is extendable upto another thirty years subject to satisfactory performance by DIAL and MIAL. Besides, Greenfield airports at Hyderabad, Bangalore and Cochin are operational under Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode.

(d) to (f): The IGI Airport, New Delhi has been awarded to DIAL, a GMR led consortium on long term lease basis. Besides, GMR group is also a major equity holder in Hyderabad International Airport Limited (HIAL) which runs Rajiv Gandhi International Airport, Hyderabad under Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode. Both the airports have been concessioned out for an initial period of thirty years which is extendable upto another thirty years subject to satisfactory performance by DIAL & HIAL.
