- (b) 135 customs sites are under EDI. These 135 sites generate more than 90% of the Custom's Revenue and account for more than 98% of import-export declarations.
- (c) & (d) Yes, CBEC, Ministry of Finance, Government of India has launched Single Window project as part of an action-plan to adopt paperless platform for regulatory clearance of import-export.
