- (a) whether the Government has reviewed the implementation of various social welfare schemes in the country particularly in Jharkhand during the last three years and the current year;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether various social welfare schemes in the country particularly in Jharkhand aimed for the welfare of the poor and tribal people have failed in achieving the present targets;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Government for effective implementation of the schemes?

(e) NITI Aayog and implementing Ministries issue advisories to States / UTs and implementing agencies for effective implementation of the schemes.
