Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is shortage of hospitals in the country particularly in tribal regions of States/UTs including Jharkhand;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to set up central Government hospital and medical colleges in these regions; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken in this regard?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI JAGAT PRAKASH NADDA)

- (a) & (b): The number of Community Health Centres, Sub-Divisional Hospitals and District Hospitals functioning in different States/UTs including Jharkhand as on 31-03-2015 as per the Rural Health Statistics 2015 is given at **Annexure-I**. The shortfall of CHCs in all states including Jharkhand is given at **Annexure-II**.
- (c) & (d): There is currently no such proposal.
