OUESTION

2159. by Shri R. DHRUVA NARAYANA:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) The number of temple, religious bodies that have deposited gold under the Gold Monetisation Scheme (GMS) so far, State-wise;
- (b) The steps being taken by the Government to attract temples that have huge gold reserves to deposit in the scheme;
- (c) Whether the Government intends to make it mandatory for temples to deposit in the scheme at any point of time in the future, if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) If not, the steps taken by the Government to persuade such religious bodies to opt for the GMS?

(a) & (b) Eight (08) temples have deposited gold under Gold Monetisation Scheme, 2015 so far and the State-wise details are as under:
