- (b) **Yes, Madam. The in-service training is recognised and equated with the first two years of graduation and the third year has to be completed by the individual through designated study centres in the Navy.**
- (c) **There is no such proposal for the present.**
- (d) **Does not arise.**
- (e) **Indian Navy gives paramount importance for Training and welfare of sailors. The training is aimed to achieve and retain the skill sets to meet the desired combat standards. Periodic review of training and processes is done and new training content is introduced as per the requirement. Modern and sophisticated training aids are exploited for imparting training to sailors.**

**Sailors are also given opportunities for their personal development through in-house training courses to improve their post retirement job prospects.**
