2214. SHRI VIJAY KUMAR HANSDAK:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of nursing colleges, both in the Government and private sector, presently existing in the country, State/UTwise;
- (b) whether the Government has received complaints against these colleges regarding the quality of education imparted by them; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government thereon?

(a): The State/UT-wise number of nursing institutions with admission capacity in India is at **Annexure**.

(b) & (c): Indian Nursing Council has taken a decision to conduct 10% surprise inspection in a year to improve the quality of nursing education. Some of the other steps taken to improve the quality of nursing education are as follows:-

1. Institution should have its own 100 bedded hospital.
2. Institution should have own building within two years of the establishment.
3. Renewals are issued every year after scrutinizing the documents w.r.t. INC norms.
4. Faculty details are to be updated on the website by the institution.
