North East Industrial & Investment Promotion Policy, 2007, Freight Subsidy scheme, 2013, Modified Industrial Infrastructure Upgradation Scheme, 2013, Special Package Schemes for the States of Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand and Indian Leather Development Programme.
