- (a) the number of people trained in the country under the scheme of Capacity Building for Service Providers during the last five years, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the funds sanctioned, released and utilised by the States in this regard; and
- (c) the details of institutions, the Ministry has tied up with to implement the said scheme?

(a) to (c): Capacity building/skill development efforts under the Scheme of Capacity Building for Service Providers are not State specific.

Subject to the Scheme guidelines the Scheme is open for implementation to the institutions like Institutes of Hotel Management and Food Craft Institutes, Indian Institute of Tourism & Travel Management (IITTM), National Council for Hotel Management and Catering Technology (NCHMCT), Tourism Departments of State/UT Government, State Tourism Development Corporations, India Tourism Development Corporation (ITDC), State/Centre Training/academic Institutions and the specialized academic training Institutes in the private sector engaged in giving training in the hospitality sector.
