(a) to (c): For development of tourism infrastructure in the country, the Ministry of Tourism has launched the Swadesh Darshan scheme-Integrated Development of Theme-Based Tourist Circuits, in 2014-15. Eco Circuit has been identified as one of the thirteen thematic circuits for development under the scheme. The Ministry has sanctioned following projects to various State Governments under Eco Circuit theme of Swadesh Darshan scheme including the State of Kerala:
