BEATING RETREAT CEREMONY IN TRIPURA

(a) to (c): Ministry of Tourism has sanctioned an amount of Rs.99.59 crore under North East Circuit of Swadesh Darshan during 2015-16 for "Development of North East Circuit: Agartala - Sipahijala - Melaghar - Udaipur - Amarpur - Tirthamukh - Mandirghat - Dumboor-Narikel Kunja - Gandachara - Ambassa", out of which Rs.9.26 crore is earmarked for Border Ceremony facility at Akaura for Conference block, wayside amenities (cafeteria), 62.5Kva DG set, open air theatre, toilet block, soil water and liquid waste management, RC retaining wall, site development, site filling, signage, and solid waste management.
