(a) to (d): The Central Government is working on a programme, namely, 'Bal Sansad' or 'Children's Parliament' to develop life skills in children, i.e. planning, problem solving, leadership, ownership, decision making, participation of children in all activities and management of the school and making school a fun-filled, joyful, and safe learning environment. The Central Government is developing the guidelines for the said programme based on the best practices of the States/UTs. Once finalized, the guidelines will be shared with the States/UTs.
