Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details and salient features of the National Career Service (NCS) scheme and Model Carrier Centre (MCC) Scheme;
- (b) whether the Government has received any proposal for upgradation of the existing employment exchanges;
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with the funds allocated and utilized for the purpose during each of the last years and the current year, State/UT-wise;
- (d) whether NCS and MCC has achieved their fixed targets and if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether the Government has organized any job fairs or employment programmes though NCS or MCC during the said period; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof, State/UT wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (IC) FOR LABOUR & EMPLOYMENT (SHRI BANDARU DATTATREYA)

(a): The NCS Project comprises a digital portal that provides a nation-wide online platform for jobseekers and employers for job matching in a dynamic, efficient and responsive manner and has a repository of career content. The NCS Portal was dedicated to the nation on 20/07/2015.

The NCS Project also envisages setting up of 100 Model Career Centres (MCCs) to be established in collaboration with States and other institutions to deliver employment services during the 12th Five Year Plan. Approval for 100 MCCs has been accorded. The MCCs envisage creating a model centre for providing variety of employment services using technology. The Government provides financial assistance to these centres based on the proposals and scheme guidelines. These model centres can be replicated by the States from their own resources.

(b) to (f): The financial details of the Model Career Centres (MCCs) being established by upgradation of Employment Exchanges are at Annex.

The Employment Exchanges function under the administrative control of the State Governments and they are organising Job Fairs locally for the benefit of the job seekers from time to time.
