Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to promote establishment of new "Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises" (MSMEs) of agro based industries and food processing industries in the country particularly in Maharashtra;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including funds allocated and utilised for the purpose during each of the last three years and the current year;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to establish 'Skill Development Training Institute' or 'Entrepreneurship Training and Development Institute' in Maharashtra to promote establishment of new MSME units; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the time by which the said institutes are likely to be established?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI GIRIRAJ SINGH)

- (a)&(b) Government in the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) has two schemes namely, Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) and Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI) which provides assistance for setting up of individual enterprises as well as cluster based enterprises in the non-farm sector by helping traditional artisans and unemployed youth. Ministry has also launched A Scheme for Promotion of Innovation, Rural Industry and Entrepreneurship (ASPIRE) which provides for setting up of incubation centres in agro-based industry for innovation and enterprise creation in micro and small scale industry including food processing. Funds utilized and employment generated during each of the last three years on Agro-based Industry including the state of Maharashtra is placed at Annexure-I.
- (c) Presently there is no such proposal.
- (d) Does not arise.
