Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government proposes to open more Kendriya Vidyalayas in Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes dominated districts which require special attention and if so, the details thereof, State/ UT and location-wise;

(b) whether the Government proposes to provide special reservation of seats for admission of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribe children in such schools and if so, the details thereof, State/UT/ location-wise;

(c) if not, the reasons therefor; and

(d) the time by which such Vidyalayas are likely to be started?

# ANSWER

# MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SMT. SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) to (d): Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) are opened primarily to cater to the educational needs of the children of transferable Central Government employees including defence and para-military personnel by providing a common programme of education. Proposals for opening of new KVs are considered only if sponsored by Ministries or Departments of the Government of India / State Governments / Union Territories Administrations and Organization of employees belonging to the eligible categories thereby committing resources for setting up a new KV as well as on the availability of necessary sanction of the Government.

As per the admission guidelines of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan, 15% seats are reserved for Scheduled Castes & 7.5% seats for Scheduled Tribes in all fresh admissions in all KVs.
