- (a) The details of funds allocated and utilized by Department of School Education & Literacy during the last three years and the current year are as under-

(b) In pursuance of Ministry of Finance D.O letter No. 32/PSO/FS/2015 dated 28th October, 2015, the sharing pattern of Schemes of National Education Mission, viz., SSA, RMSA, Teacher Training and Adult Education and Mid-Day Meal programme has been revised to 60:40 w.e.f 2015-16, and 90:10 for the 8 North-Eastern and 3 Himalayan States of Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand. For Union Territories, the Centrally sponsored schemes are funded 100% by the Central Government.

(c) and (d) The Scheme of District Primary Education Programme (DPEP) was launched in 1994 as a major initiative to achieve the objective of Universalisation of Primary school education. This was replaced by Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) in 2000-01. Currently the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) is implemented as Centrally Sponsored Scheme in partnership with State Governments for universalising elementary education across the country.

The State-wise details of central fund released during the last three years and funds certified to be released (as part of 1st instalment) during the current financial year, under SSA are at **Annexure**.
