(a) to (c): The recruitment and service conditions of teachers are primarily in the domain of State Governments/UT Administrations. The Central Government through Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan and Rashtriya Madyamik Shiksha Abhiyan provides assistance to State Governments/UTs for additional teachers to maintain appropriate Pupil Teacher Ratio as per the requirements of the States/UTs.
