- (b) the number of applications for minority status submitted by schools during the same period and the action taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SMT. SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a): The National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions (NCMEI) has informed that it has granted minority status to 4895 schools from 2012 to 2015. State-wise details are at Annexure.
- (b): 10,661 applications were received by NCMEI for grant of Minority Status Certificates during the same period. The Commission granted Minority Status Certificates to 4895 schools after verifying the records as per procedure laid down.
