SETTING UP OF INDIAN CULINARY INSTITUTES

2516. SHRI MANOJ TIWARI:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to establish 'Indian Culinary Institutes' in different cities of the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard;
- (c) the funds allocated by the Government in this regard; and
- (d) the time by which the said institutes are likely to be set up?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (DR. MAHESH SHARMA)

(a) to (d): The Ministry of Tourism (MoT) has approved the setting up of the Indian Culinary Institute (ICI) at Tirupati, with its Northern Regional Centre at Noida.

MoT has sanctioned an amount of Rs.97.92 crores for setting up Indian Culinary Institue at Tirupati and Rs.90.00 crores for setting up Indian Culinary Institue in Noida.

Construction work has commenced at both the locations.

The implementation period of each project is 24 months.
