CAMPA Funds

2637. SHRI VIKRAM USENDI :

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FORESTS AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state :

- (a) the amount sanctioned to various States from Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) Head during each of the last three years and the current year State-wise including Chhattisgarh;
- (b) the names of the States wherein funds from CAMPA Head has been used for the revival of forests;
- (c) whether the amount allocated under CAMPA is being diverted for other purposes by some States;
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and
- (e) the details of areas in which plantation has been done under CAMPA and the amount spent thereon, State-wise?

- (a)&(b) A statement showing the funds released to various State CAMPAs against the Annual Plans of Operation drawn up by the States for the years 2013-14, 2014-15 & 2015-16 is enclosed as Annexure 'A'. No funds have so far been released to the State CAMPAs in the present year viz., 2016-17 ;
- (c)&(d) CAMPA funds released to the States can only be used for the activities included in the respective Annual Plans of Operation, which are drawn up in terms of the Guidelines for State CAMPAs, which have the approval of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India ;
- (e) The State-wise details of compensatory afforestation undertaken upto 31st March 2015 are shown in the statement at Annexure 'B'.
