(a) & (b): Yes Madam. Narcotics Control Bureau(NCB) has busted many international drug traffickers that made use of courier/ postal services to smuggle drugs. The data of traffickers both Indian and foreigners are furnished below.

- (c): The following measures are taken by the Government to check drug smuggling through postal services:
  - (i) Department of Posts has laid down revised procedure for booking and processing of International parcels according to which Know your Customer (KYC) norms are mandatory. Identity and address proof are necessary for booking the shipments.
  - (ii) Training programmes are being regularly conducted for courier companies officials.
  - (iii) New emerging trends and modus operandi are studied and analysed by NCB and sharing of information with courier companies regarding emerging trends and modus operandi being used by drug traffickers.
  - (iv) Employees of Postal Services and Courier companies are regularly sensitized to check the identity proofs and profiling of the consignors and also to keep xerox copy of consignor's ID proof specially passport/visa in case of foreign national.
