Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of existing strength and requirement of Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs), force and rank-wise;
- (b) whether there is shortage of CAPF personnel in the country;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor along with the total number of posts lying vacant, rank and force-wise separately including CISF and ITBP;
- (d) whether the Government has carried out any assessment of the requirement of CAPF personnel recently and if so, the details thereof, force-wise including ITBP;
- (e) the action taken by the Government in this regard;
- (f) whether the Government has any proposal to conduct recruitment drive for CAPF personnel including CISF; and
- (g) if so, the details thereof and the time by which recruitment is likely to be conducted, force-wise including CISF and ITBP?
