STORAGE CAPACITY OF FCI

2693. SHRI SANJAY DHOTRE:

Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION उपभोक्ता मामले, खाद्य और सार्वजनिक वितरण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Food Corporation of India (FCI) has increased its own storage capacity in the country during each of the last three years and the current year, if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;
- (b) if not, the reasons therefor along with the number of godowns hired by FCI to meet its storage requirement across the country and the rent/expenses incurred thereon during the said period, State/UTwise;
- (c) whether the Government has conducted any study to ascertain the funds required to increase the owned storage capacity of FCI and the rent/expenses required for hiring of godowns to meet its storage requirement in the country during the said period, if so, the details and the outcome thereof; and
- (d) the other steps taken by the Government to increase owned storage capacity of FCI to meet its storage requirement instead of hiring of godowns in the country?

A N S W E R MINISTER OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD & PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SHRI RAM VILAS PASWAN)

(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. FCI has been augmenting its own storage capacity using funds under Plan scheme mostly in the North Eastern states. For rest of the country, as a policy, storage capacity has been augmented under Private Entrepreneurs Guarantee (PEG) Scheme where godowns are dedicated for FCI for 10 years for storage of foodgrains.

The details of capacity augmentation during the last three years and current year are given below:-
