- (a) whether the Government is planning to phase out support to pharma industry by 2020, if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (b) whether any reaction/resistance has come from pharma industry in this regard; and
- (c) the steps being taken by the Government to increase the support to pharma industry towards research and development?

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI HANSRAJ GANGARAM AHIR)

- (a): No, Madam.
- (b): In view of the reply(a) above, does not arise.
- (c): The Government is providing financial support for research and development through Drugs & Pharmaceuticals Research Programme (DPRP) run by the Department of Science & Technology. Besides this, the Department of Pharmaceuticals is planning to start Venture Capital Fund for supporting innovation. The companies undertaking Research & Development activities are provided certain income tax benefits, The Drug (Prices Control) Order, 2013, Para-32(iii) provides exemptions from price control to a manufacturer producing a new drug involving a new delivery system developed through indigenous Research and Development for a period of five years from the date of its market approval in India.
