Monsoon Prediction

2768. SHRI JAYADEV GALLA:

Will the Minister of EARTH SCIENCES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is possibility of La Nina developing in the second half of this year;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the manner in which La Nina is helpful in getting more rains in the country?

ANSWER

- (a-b) The latest model forecasts from Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology (IITM)'s coupled ocean-atmospheric model and other international models indicate that the probability of development of La Nina condition increases towards the latter half of the year. Nearly all models predict weakening of El Niño, with a transition to El Niño-neutral conditions to develop likely during later half of the summer monsoon season (August-September) of 2016. Subsequently, the chance of La Niña development increases during the last quarter of 2016.
- (c) The occurrence of La-Nina (anomalous cooling of Sea Surface Temperature of Equatorial Pacific ocean waters) has high positive correlation with Indian summer monsoon rainfall (ISMR). La-Nina <u>events</u> are generally associated with normal to above normal monsoons.
