- (a) whether the Railways has any guidelines/policies/rules in place in respect of film shooting in railway stations across the country;
- (b) if so, the guidelines that exist at present;
- (c) if not, whether the Railways proposes to bring out a list of guidelines for the same; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

- (b) Guidelines for film shooting in railway stations across the country inter alia covers the following aspects:
 - (i) Procedure for submitting applications and authorities concerned.
 - (ii) Need for prior Clearance from other Ministries, such as Ministry of Information & Broadcasting, Ministry of External Affairs, where required.
 - (iii) Security clearance of locations in accordance with guidelines issued by Ministry of Home Affairs,
 - (iv) Grant of permission following conditions applicable to film shooting, Security deposit, Licence fee, comprehensive insurance, indemnity bond & agreement, etc.
- (c) & (d): Do not arise.
