TOILETS IN ANGANWADIS AND SCHOOLS

ADV. NARENDRA KESHAV SAWAIKAR:

Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of target fixed by the Government for construction of household latrines, school toilets, anganwadi toilets, etc. under Swachh Bharat Mission in urban areas during 2015-16;
- (b) whether some of the States have failed to achieve the target particularly in the construction of anganwadi toilets;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and
- (d) whether the Government proposes to consider directing States to achieve the target fixed and also cover the earlier target during 2016-17?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT

(SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO)

(a) to (c): Under Swachh Bharat Mission Urban a target of 25 lakh individual household toilets was fixed for 2015-16.

Under Swachh Vidyalaya initiative about 11.08 lakh government schools across the country have access to gender segregated functional toilets under Swachh Vidyalaya initiative of separate girls' and boy's toilets in all government schools.

About 52% Anganwadi Centre's (AWCs) have toilets. State-Wise details are annexed.

(d) Ministry of Urban Development reviews the progress of Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban) in States on a day-to-day basis and also on monthly basis through video conferences/teleconferences, meetings

with State Mission Directors and also provide onsite technical assistance to effectively implement the Mission across the country.

As for the Anganwadi Centre's, States/ UTs have been requested to construct AWC buildings including toilets facilities at AWCs by liveraging funds from various scheme viz. MPLADs, MLALADs, Backward Region Grant Funds (BRGF)/ Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRI), Rural Infrastructure Development Funds (RIDF), Multi Sectotal Development Programme of Minority Affairs, Rural Development, State Plan and Area Development Plan etc.
