- (a) Whether the Government has received proposal for Mono rail projects from various States;
- (b) If so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c) Whether all the said proposals have been approved;
- (d) If so, the details and the present status of these projects; and
- (e) If not, the reasons therefor?

to (e) :Government of India has received a proposal from (a) Government of Tamil Nadu for 'in-principle' approval implementing a Monorail Project (Phase-I) from Poonamallee to Kathipara with a link from Porur to Vadaplani of about 20.68 kms at an estimated cost of Rs.3267 crores under Design, Build, Finance, Operation & Transfer (DBFOT) model. Government of India, vide letter dated 11.11.2014 has accorded 'In principle' approval without any financial liability to the project. Government of Tamil Nadu has informed that the opening of bid for award of the concession is scheduled on 31.05.2016.
