### Vacant Posts in Universities

29. SHRI CHANDU LAL SAHU: SHRI OM BIRLA:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the vacant posts of professors and associate-professors in Universities in the country for Scheduled Tribes including Chhattisgarh and Rajasthan, State-wise;
- (b) the details of the ST posts vacant in institutions in Chhattisgarh, Rajasthan, University-wise;
- (c) the number and details of ST candidates who have cleared the UGC-NET exam during the last three years, State-wise; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government to include timely and adequate candidates reserved for these positions?

# ANSWER MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SMT. SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a): The University Grants Commission (UGC) has provided the State-wise details of the vacant posts of professors and associate-professors belonging to Scheduled Tribes in Central Universities which are granted salary and maintenance grants by the UGC, are at **Annexure-I**. The UGC does not provide salary and maintenance grants for regular teaching positions in State Universities. The details of vacancy in the State Universities are not centrally maintained.
- (b): The details of the ST posts vacant in Central Universities in Chhattisgarh and Rajasthan are at **Annexure-II**.
- (c): The details of the ST candidates, who have cleared the UGC-NET exam during the last three years, State-wise are at **Annexure-III**.
- (d): Arising of vacancies and filling them is a continuous process. The Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) and the UGC continuously monitors the filling up of vacancies in the institutions maintained by the UGC. The MHRD and UGC issues instructions from time to time to all Central Universities and Deemed Universities for (i) Implementation of Reservation Policy of the Government (ii) Display of reservation roster on University website and (iii) Adequate measures for filling up of backlog reserved vacancies. In the Central Universities Vice Chancellors' Conference, held on 4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> February, 2015 and the Visitor's Conference, held on 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> November, 2015, the Vice Chancellors were exhorted to fill up the vacant position of teachers in a time bound manner.
