(a) to (c): Ministry of Railways had not appointed Indian Institute of Management, Ahmedabad (IIM-A) for conducting any study regarding Mumbai-Ahmedabad High Speed train project. However, working paper has been published by IIM- Ahmedabad on the subject in March, 2016 for academic purpose which is available at IIM, Ahmedabad website www.iimahd.ernet.in.

The working paper has concluded that (i) There are many positive benefits and externalities of High Speed Rail which would be useful for India's overall aspirational development, (ii) Mumbai-Ahmedabad route is a good choice for the first route. (iii) Low cost Japanese financing will be a great catalyst.
