(a) to (c): Government has not conducted a study on per capita per year expenditure on urban infrastructure, however, as per the report published by Mckinsey Global Institute in 2010 titled 'India's urban awakening: Building inclusive cities, sustaining economic growth', the per capita spending on urban infrastructure services for India, UK, China and South Africa is as under:

Per capita spending on urban infrastructure services (in US \$) at FY 2007- 2008 prices				
Sl.No.	Country	Capital expenditure	Operational expenditure	Total expenditure
1.	India	17	33	50
2.	China	116	246	362
3.	South Africa	127	381	508
4.	United Kingdom	391	1,381	1,772

As per the report, India's per capita expenditure on urban infrastructure is less than the countries mentioned.
