HUBLI HEADQUARTER OF SOUTHERN RAILWAY

2957. KUMARI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Hubli is the headquarter of South Western Railway zone in Karnataka but even being a major junction of South India, it has not been provided with a superfast train for Delhi and if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether the Government proposes to run a new superfast/high speed train from Hubli to Delhi; and

(c) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) Hubballi is the zonal Headquarter of South Western Railway in Karnataka. At present, 4 pairs of Superfast Express trains are already available between Delhi and Hubballi as under:-

- 1. 12781/12782 Mysuru-Hazrat Nizamuddin Swarna Jayanti Express (weekly)**
- 2. 22685/22686 Yesvantpur-Chandigarh Express (bi-weekly)**
- 3. 12629/12630 Yesvantpur-Hazrat Nizamuddin Sampark Kranti Express (bi-weekly)**
- 4. 17305/17306 Hubballi-Londa-Hazrat Nizamuddin Link Express (daily)**

(b) and (c) At present, there is no proposal to introduce new superfast/high speed train between Hubballi and Delhi due to operational and resource constraints.
