REPRESENTATION OF TRIBALS IN CAPF

327. SHRI B. SRIRAMULU:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the representation of tribals have decreased in Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF) such as CRPF, BSF and CISF;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to increase the representation of tribals in CAPF?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI KIREN RIJIJU)

- (a) to (b): There is no decrease in representation of Schedule Tribes in BSF, CISF, ITBP & Assam Rifles. There is a minor decrease in CRPF and SSB. The Force wise representation of tribals as on 01.01.2015 and 01.01.2016 is enclosed as per Annexure-I.
- (c): The following steps have been taken to increase the representation of tribals in CAPFs:
 - i) Imparting of finishing training and interview skills.
 - ii) Conduct of separate recruitment drives for allied officers.
- iii) Wide publicity to special recruitment drives by forwarding copies to National Commission for SC/ST and State Commissions.
