City Compost

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FORESTS AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has a policy on promotion of city compost to reduce the volume of waste to landfill/ dumpsite by converting the waste into useful by-products and also to prevent production of harmful greenhouse gases (especially methane) and toxic material that pollutes groundwater apart from polluting the environment;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether a provision has been made for market development assistance of Rs. 1500 per tonne of city compost for scaling up production and consumption of the product; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) Yes, Madam. The Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 notified on 8th April, 2016 provide for Promotion of City Compost. As per the approved policy measure a provision has been made for Market Development Assistance of Rs.1500 per tonne of City Compost for production and consumption of the product with a aim to lower MRP of City Compost for farmers, toreduce the volume of waste to landfill / dumpsite, to convert the waste into useful by-products, to help in keeping the city clean and to prevent production of harmful greenhouse gases and toxic material that pollutes the environment. A provision is also made for comarketing of City Compost with chemical fertilizers by fertilizer companies through their dealer network.
