- (b) the funds released/grants provided in this regard during each of the last three years and the current year, State-wise including Kerala;
- (c) whether there are huge dues in grant and delay in disbursement of such funds during the last three years;
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) whether the Government proposes to enhance the honorarium of the teaching and non-teaching staff of such schools and if so, the details thereof?

- (a) & (b) A statement indicating the details of the special schools for development of disabled children functioning in the country and the funds released/grants provided in this regard during each of the last three years and the current year, State wise including Kerela under Deendayal Disabled Rehabilitation Scheme (DDRS) is at **Annexure**.
- (c) & (d) All complete proposals, which fulfill norms of the schemes, received during the financial year, are processed and grants considered subject to availability of funds. However, in case of deficiency in any of the documents/proposals, the grant is released only after rectification of the deficiency, in consonance with the provisions of General Financial Rules.
- (e) The matter is under consideration of the Department.
